A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

*To the Disciples in Christ of St. Luke Lutheran Church,
This is an article I'd like to share written by the Director of Evangelical
Mission from the SW Pennsylvania Synod about evangelism. In order to
grow the Kingdom of Heaven, we must spread the Good News of Christ.
Please consider the offering below and try to incorporate these practices
into your daily life.*

***BUT I DON'T KNOW HOW TO WITNESS! Fact: Lutherans are afraid of
evangelism.***

*In the Lutheran Church, we don't talk much about how to witness our faith
person to person. We tend to be quiet and shy. But all of us who are
Christians are already witnesses to the faith. It is not an option; it is a fact.
The only question is whether or not we are helpful or not helpful witnesses!
Here are some key things that helpful witnesses are doing faithfully:
PRAY Pray regularly for people in your circle of friends, relatives and
acquaintances who are unchurched or even de-churched. A few of
those people could be a part of your daily prayer life. When you are with
them, be in prayer for them in the midst of your interaction.*

LISTEN *It is a powerful, loving gift to listen to someone. This is particularly
important in witnessing. Bringing Jesus to others is not about your
dumping your statement of belief on them or sending them on a guilt trip
about missing church. This is about listening to see how God is leading
you to care about the needs, challenges, and hopes in life of one of God's
other children.*

LOVE *This goes hand and hand with listening. As you listen, you will have
opportunities to respond in care for them. You carry the loving presence*

of God to them. Look for ways to provide caring support. Pray that God will give you the wisdom to see how your gifts can be helpful in meeting their needs.

SHARE Pray for insight into how you can best share the good news of Jesus with them. Your life has been graced by Christ, and at the proper moment, share how what has happened in your life through Jesus might overlap with their situation. This might happen quickly or may take some time. Don't manipulate the conversation so that you can tell your story. Instead, think of witnessing as journeying with someone and finding out that how God has touched your life has meaning for someone else's life experience.

We ARE witnesses of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It is essential that we continue to grown in our ability to be better at the central commission that comes from our Lord.
